

Background


he story of our University has gone through five periods:

- The first period between 1962-1975 begins with the offering of studies, complementary to the formation of cadets at the Escuela Militar de Cadetes "José María Córdova" (J.M.C Military School), with the programs of Economics, Diplomatic and Consular Law and Civil Engineering.
- During the second period, 1976-1981, the undergraduate programs for civilians were opened, the School of Medicine was created (1978), the status of University Center is granted, and for the first time a president for the institution is appointed (1980).
- During the third period, 1982-1994, the institution was granted the status of University (1982), ascribed to the Ministry of Defense, as a Special Administrative Unit.
- In the fourth period, 1994-2003, the approval of the General Statute and the Internal Structure is achieved.
- Finally, between 2003-2011, through ACT 805 of 2003 the academic, administrative and financial autonomy, as well as the legal entity status were granted.

Legal Status

he Universidad Militar Nueva Granada is an autonomous university entity of a national order with a special organic regime, whose main goal deals with higher education geared to academically support the Military Forces, the National Police and the Defense Sector, and all its active or retired members, their families and the civilians in general.

It is ascribed to the Ministry of National Education, following its policies and planning of the education sector.

In the Nueva Granada Campus branch (km. 2 VíaCajicá – Zipaquirá) one can find the School of Applied Biology, the premedical courses, and programs such as Public Accounting, Law, Ingeniería Civil, International Affairs, Horticulture Technology, Prehospital care, and Technology in Accounting and Tax.

The university also grants discounts to the spouses and children of military, police and Defense sector personnel.








Scholarships and Discounts

he Universidad Militar Nueva Granadaprovides medical and dental assistance with special rates, free psychological assistance, virtual and physical library, video beam, video, overhead, opaque, and slide projectors, filming equipment, sound computers in most classrooms and special, well-equipped rooms, internet rooms, computer rooms with internet access, gym for physical maintenance and aerobics under the supervision of expert trainers.

The University provides a variety of extracurricular activities and sports such as soccer, futsal, basketball, volleyball, tennis, ping pong, chess, karate-do, cheerleading, and swimming, as well as guitar, plastic arts, acting, and dancinglessons, and a variety of musical groups that includes tuna, chirimia, Cuban son, Colombian music, rock group, choir and orchestra.
